Note: When a Strike Force is requested, the Area Coordinator or one of his assistants should be notified. When dispatching ANY Strike Force, a Strike Force Leader MUST be selected from one of the departments involved in the Strike Force. The Coordinator should make the selection based on availability or expertise. Water Supply Leaders are listed above.

An assembly or staging area that is convenient for all apparatus should also be selected. The assembly area is where all apparatus should respond to allow for the Strike Force units to arrive at the same time. This will insure the Strike Force Leader of his resources and allow him to maintain accountability of the Strike Force personnel. Out of County Assembly Areas are listed above.

Below is a step by step course of action to assist the dispatcher in dispatching a Strike Force.

1. When receiving the call for a Strike Force, some may not understand the system and just ask for a Strike Force. A determination must be made as to what type of Strike Force is needed and if it is to respond urgent or non-urgent. Also ascertain what frequency or frequencies the Strike Force Leader should use to communicate with the Dispatch Center and Command.
2. Make contact with the Area Coordinator using the following order. Nextel Direct connect 140*47*5800 or cell 314-220-5430, 5800 officer tone, office 636-586-2557, home 636-586-4374, pager 636-896-3900. If not available, contact an Assistant Area Coordinator.
3. Advise Coordinator of the Strike Force assignment and if the units from the appropriate list are in service and able to respond.
4. Go over "designated out of County assembly areas" and ask Coordinator to select assembly area and Strike Force Leader with at least one alternate in the event the selection is not available.
5. Dispatch equipment and Leader giving the information on the alarm they will be assisting on along with the assembly area, response mode and proper frequency or frequencies.
6. After units respond, get a manpower count and advise the Coordinator and Strike Force Leader.
7. Notify Central County Dispatch and advise them the State Wide Mutual Aid System has been activated. Give a brief description of the activation and advise them to notify the Regional Coordinator. Any other requests for Strike Forces will include an additional notification to Central County Dispatch.
